

Mouth of the Platte

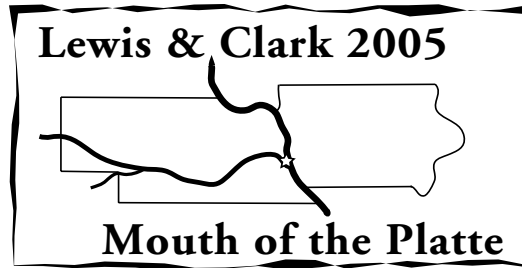

The national bicentennial commemoration of the Lewis & Clark Expedition runs from 2003 through 2006. Millions of visitors are expected to visit some part of the national Lewis & Clark Historic Trail, from Thomas Jefferson's Monticello home in Virginia to the Expedition's winter quarters at the mouth of the Columbia River on the Pacific Coast.

The Expedition traveled 2400 miles along the Missouri River. Many visitors are following their route.

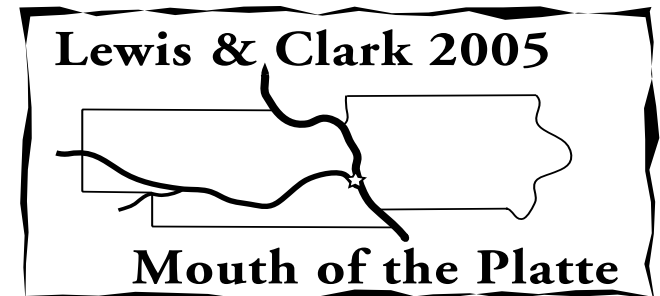
